## The Sustainable Rural Healthcare Hubs trial program is available here.

The Hubs trial program aims to provide coordinated care for people with health conditions that would benefit from a more comprehensive management plan.

People taking part in the program will receive care and support in addition to their usual GP appointments, including from a Nurse Practitioner, Care Coordinator and allied health professionals, and any other people you would like involved in your care team.

As a trial program, if you are taking part you will be invited to participate in the evaluation which can include surveys and Journey Mapping.

Your feedback will help improve healthcare in the Buloke, Loddon and Gannawarra Shires.
